What is HealthPathways?

- HealthPathways is a clinical management support tool used by GP's during a patient consultation. The program is jointly delivered by the PHN and LHD
- HealthPathways details up-to-date clinical management, referral information and resources that are localised to the NBM Region
- Pathway content is developed by a local GP, Subject Matter Experts - Specialists, and Streamliners (NZ).

Health Pathways of interest

- Comprehensive suite of Women's Health pathways that covers Contraception and Sterilisation, Pregnancy, Breastfeeding and Gynaecology.
- Public Health section covers childhood Immunisation and is updated yearly
- Abuse, Violence and neglect section covers Domestic and Family Violence, Sexual Assault and Strangulation

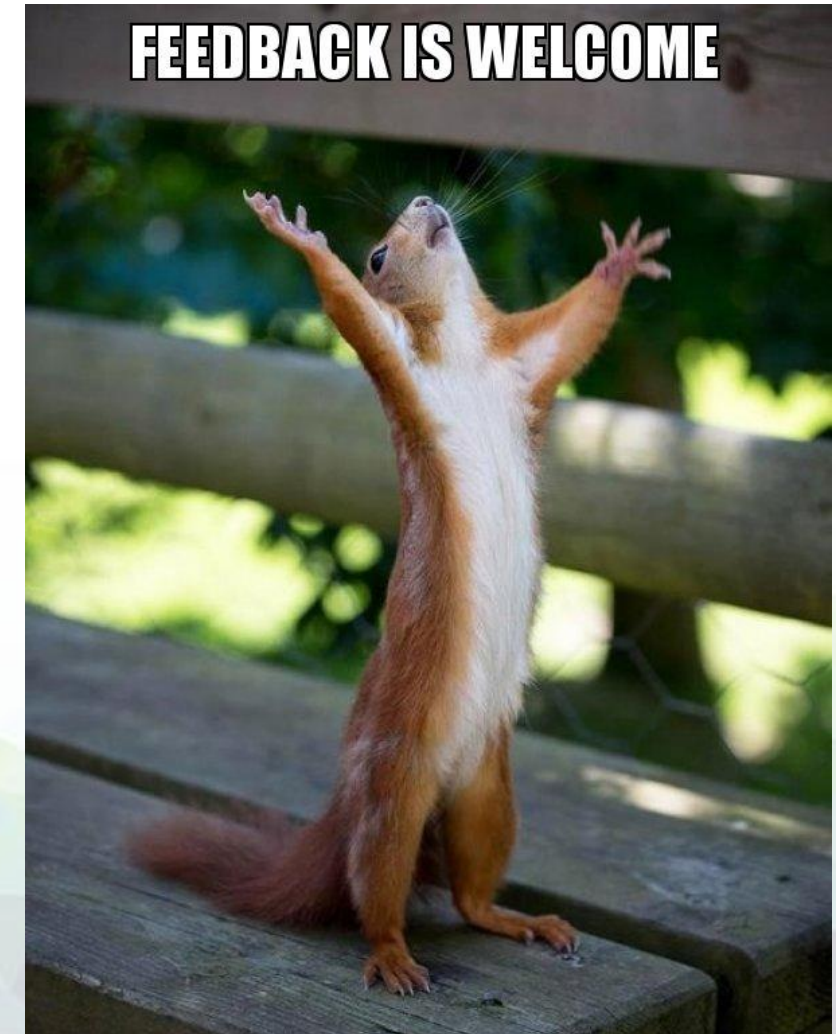
Nepean Blue Mountains ANSC Program

1. Check [criteria and exclusions](#) ▼.
2. Discuss antenatal shared care with the patient and confirm their wish to engage in this program.
3. If not an ANSC Program provider, refer patient to a [local antenatal clinic](#) with referral letter indicating the patient's wish to engage in antenatal shared care.
4. If registered as an ANSC GP provider, follow the [Antenatal Shared Care Protocol](#) [\[link\]](#).

Becoming an ANSC GP provider

1. Register your interest to become an ANSC provider with NBMPHN and:
 - complete the [GP ANSC registration form](#) [\[link\]](#),
 - provide evidence of current medical registration, and
 - provide evidence of current Professional Indemnity Insurance.
2. Complete an orientation session with NBMPHN Antenatal Shared Care Program team.
 - This can be done face-to-face in your general practice (preferable) or may be included as part of a GP Antenatal Shared Care Education Event.
