Our outreach clinic supports individuals who are aged 17 or older and require psychiatric care, and:

- Have diagnosed ADHD and are transitioning from paediatric to GP-led care, or
- Are Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander, or
- Hold a Centrelink-issued healthcare card, family healthcare card, or pension card.

Referrals are made exclusively by GPs.

Any GP in the Nepean Blue Mountains region can make a referral.
